Course Objectives:

What is covered:

4. *Timber Treatment – diagnosis and treatment of fungal decay and insect infestation.*
5. *Tanking & Basement conversion – selection of most appropriate system and basic principles of installation.*
6. *Remedial pointing (Kwikpoint) and effective treatment of "penetrating damp"*
7. *Associated products & their usage.*
8. *Issuing Guarantees – procedures and forms.*

Upon completion of the course you will have achieved provisional "APPROVED CONTRACTOR" status and will be issued with a Bi-annual registration certificate. The "provisional" phase of the approval process allows us to assess how well you have applied the principles outlined in the training course, in practice on a real job. It is essential therefore that you make a basic photographic record of your first two jobs: before, during and after. These photographs are to be submitted to Kingfisher in electronic form. - 1. From M6, Junction 36, take the A590 West following signs for "Barrow-in-Furness" & "Ulverston".*
- NOTE: You are now on the A590 Dual Carriageway BUT after 3 miles the road splits. TAKE THE SLIP ROAD ON THE LEFT, DO NOT HEAD FOR KENDAL!!!*
- 2. At the end of the slip road is a round about, take the first exit following signs for "Barrow-in-Furness" & "Ulverston".*
- 3. Stick to the main A590 through roundabouts at "Grange over Sands" and "Newby Bridge" following signs for "Barrow-in-Furness" & "Ulverston".*
- 4. Ulverston. Mini round about at BOOTH'S supermaket STRAIGHT ON passing SHELL on RHS.*
- 5. 200 metres TURN LEFT onto A5087 (Bardsea, Coast road).*
- 6. Follow A5087 for approx 3 miles passing leisure centre on left and continuing out of Ulverston into open countryside. Kingfisher is well sign posted on the left 500m past MANJUSHRI PRIORY.*
