DESCRIPTION.

Kingfisher Insecticide/Fungicide Wood Preservative, is an organic, solvent based solution, formulated with active ingredients to give protection against mould, fungi and insect infestation. The product contains ingredients which are proven to be highly effective in controlling insect infestation and mould and fungi growth but are of low mammalian toxicity.

The carefully selected ingredients ensure that the product is suitable for use in bat roosts.

Kingfisher Insecticide/Fungicide Wood Preservative has been developed for application to structural woodwork to eradicate existing insect infestation or as a means of protection for sound structures.

APPLICATION

Kingfisher Insecticide/Fungicide Wood Preservative is supplied ready to use and can be applied by dipping, brushing or the use of low pressure liquid spray equipment (not air driven) to achieve saturation of the area of woodwork being treated.

COVERAGE.

1 litre of **Kingfisher Insecticide/Fungicide Wood Preservative** will cover approximately 2 sq.mtrs.

CONDITIONS for SAFE USAGE.

Kingfisher Insecticide/Fungicide Wood Preservative is an organic solvent based solution which has a flash point of 40.5°C. It must therefore be stored and treated as flammable.

This is particularly important when spraying as atomisation of the solution can lower the flash point.

Avoid all sources of ignition and do not use near hot surfaces or where naked flames may be present. Users must wear nose and mouth masks and eye protection when spraying the product.

Keep spray mist to a minimum.

Soiled overalls should be removed and well aired to avoid spontaneous combustion which could occur if they are left in bundles.

These precautions are normal recognised good practice when using any organic solvent based product.
