



KINGFISHER TIMBER PASTE

For use only by professional operators

DESCRIPTION.

Kingfisher TIMBER PASTE is a creamy white paste which, when applied to timber, kills all known species of insect and fungi which cause decay. It self penetrates through any thickness of wood after application, killing insects and fungi and preserving the timber against future attack

PREPARATION.

All surfaces to be treated should be brushed down to remove contamination and loose debris.

APPLICATION

Apply **Kingfisher TIMBER PASTE** using a brush, trowel or gun to the recommended loading.

COVERAGE.

Coverage is dependent upon timber thickness. Typically 0.8 litres per sq. metre for 25mm thick timber.

PACKAGING.

Kingfisher TIMBER PASTE is available in 10 litre containers or in cases of 12 x 380ml tubes.
