



KINGFISHER CLEAR WOOD PRESERVATIVE

DESCRIPTION.

Kingfisher CLEAR WOOD PRESERVATIVE is a spirit based penetrating treatment containing active fungicides specifically developed for use on structural woodwork.

It is ready to use and designed to be compatible with most finishing systems and decorative products such as stains and paints.

The preservatives will penetrate into the wood and do not form a surface coating.

APPLICATION

Kingfisher CLEAR WOOD PRESERVATIVE can be applied by immersion, brush or spray, to refusal.

Rate of drying is controlled by the rate of evaporation of the solvent content and will vary depending upon weather conditions. Complete drying typically requires 2–3 days.

Treatment by immersion is the normal method of application and involves a minimum of three (3) minutes dip to achieve maximum absorption of the active preservative components.

The period of immersion can be increased up to 15 minutes for resistant timbers such as Hemlock, or for components which are in hazardous environments when used.

COVERAGE.

The typical usage rate is 2m² /litre for all applications.

PACKAGING.

Available in 5 litre and 25 litre containers.

HEALTH and SAFETY.

- To be used only as a wood preservative.
- **Only to be used by professional operators.**
- Flammable. (Flash Point 40°C) Do not apply in the presence of naked flames, hot surfaces or unprotected electrical equipment.
- Wear suitable protective overalls and rubber/PVC gloves and eye protection when applying.
- **DO NOT** work in spray mist, otherwise wear suitable respiratory equipment and eye protection.
- Engineering controls may replace PPE if a COSHH assessment shows that they provide an equal or higher standard of protection.
- When using, **DO NOT EAT, DRINK or SMOKE.**

- Wash hands and exposed skin before meals and after work.
- Harmful to aquatic organisms, may cause long term adverse effects in the aquatic environment.
- Keep away from food, drink and animal feedstuffs.
- **REMOVE or COVER** fish tanks and bowls before application.
- **DO NOT** contaminate watercourses or ground with chemicals or used containers.
- **REMOVE or COVER** foodstuffs, food preparing equipment and eating utensils before application.
- **DO NOT** apply to surfaces on which food or feed is stored, prepared, or eaten.
- **DO NOT** use on **beehives or beekeeping equipment**.
- **COVER** water storage tanks **BEFORE** application.
- This material and its container must be disposed of as per instructed in the MSDS.
- Bats are protected under The Wildlife Countryside Act 1981. Therefore **BEFORE TREATING** any structure used by bats please consult with English Nature, Scottish National Heritage or the Countryside Council for Wales.
- Children and pets should be kept away from treated areas for 48 hours – until surfaces are dry.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Ventilate confined spaces thoroughly before occupying.
